Engineering Economics, Inc. Donates Building Commissioning Services for Haiti Orphanage and Children's Center Project

Golden, Colorado – July 5, 2011 – Engineering Economics, Inc. (EEI) is donating Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED®) Building Commissioning services in support of the construction of the Haiti Orphanage and Children's Center project in Port au Prince, Haiti.

Sponsored by the United States Green Building Council (USGBC) in partnership with Lend Lease Corporation, the Haiti Orphanage and Children's Center will replace the original orphanage significantly damaged in the January 2010 earthquake and subsequently condemned. The replacement facility will be operated by the Foundation Enfant Jesus.
